The publisher must send one copy of the publication(s) in which the reproduction appears to the MOA Registration Department.

To ensure accuracy in the reproduction one (1) proof must be submitted to the MOA Registration Department for comparison with the original BEFORE publication. The department will advise the publisher of necessary adjustment or grant approval of the proof.

#### **CONDITION OF USE:**

- All applications must be received in writing.
- Please visit the MOA website moa.byu.edu to search the collection and identify what images you are requesting by the nine digit accession number.
- Files will be provided electronically. They are ONLY to be used for the purposes set forth in this agreement and for none other. Files are not to be shared, distributed or saved in any form other than for the publication design layout.
- A Credit Line will be provided for use with the image(s).
- An invoice will accompany the images; payment is to be made in US currency on all orders. Checks or money orders should be made out to Brigham Young University and sent to Brigham Young University, North Campus Drive 120 MOA, Provo UT 84602
- Normal processing time is 15 working days. A rush charge (minimum \$25.00) will be added to any order requiring less time.

CONDITIONS under which permission is granted to reproduce works of art in the collection of the Brigham Young University Museum of Art (herein identified as MOA) appear below. Permission to reproduce is conditioned upon acceptance of these regulations. Any breach of these terms and conditions will automatically result, at the sole discretion of the MOA, in revocation of permission to reproduce.

- All reproductions must be made from photographic materials supplied by the MOA. Reproduction from printed or other non-photographic materials is strictly prohibited.
- 2. The credit line provided must accompany the reproduction, either directly under it, on the page facing, on the reverse, or elsewhere in the book such as in the index or list of illustrations. In the case of television, film, video, DVD or CD a general attribution must be included in the credits. In the case of the internet credit must accompany the reproduction either directly under the image or next to it.
- 3. Permission is granted for only one usage in one publication, one edition, and one language. Any further reproduction shall require an additional fee and written permission from the MOA.
- 4. The reproduction must be printed in full tone black and white or full color and may not be reproduced on colored stock. Nothing may be superimposed on the image (i.e., lettering or another image) without approval of the MOA. Permission here is limited to book and catalogue covers of academic and museum publications where the image is reproduced in its entirety within.
- 5. The work must be reproduced in its entirety and must not be bled off the page or cropped in any way without permission of the MOA. Permission here is limited to book and catalogue covers of academic and museum publications where the image is reproduced in its entirety within.
  - The reproduction of a specific detail must be approved in advance by the MOA; the fact that it is a detail must be noted in the credit line accompanying the reproduction. For use in video productions panning and/or zooming in or out of the entire image is permitted provided the details thus produced are closely associated with the image.
- The MOA may order, at any time of printing, any overrun it may desire to be paid for at cost or at a discount to be worked out between the MOA and the publisher.

- 7. The MOA gives no exclusive rights to any publisher, author or photographer and makes no warranties or representations and assumes no responsibilities whatsoever for any claims against the applicant or the MOA by an artist, his/her agent, estate, or any other party in connection with the reproduction of the works of art in the collections of the MOA. Additionally, the applicant agrees to indemnify the MOA and hold it harmless against any and all such claims, including copyright infringement claims, royalty or fee demands and/or actions, including the costs thereof, arising as a result of the applicants reproduction of the works of art in the collections of the MOA.
  - The MOA will attempt to provide accurate and up-to-date information regarding the copyright status of the specific work requested; however, it is the responsibility of the publisher to directly contact the copyright owner. Any or all royalty payments or other requirements specified by the copyright owner must be adhered to by the publisher or agent requesting reproduction permission.
- 8. Any unauthorized use of photographic materials supplied by the MOA by any person or entity, for any reason, will render the applicant responsible and liable to the MOA for appropriate compensation and other costs, regardless of whether the applicant profited from or is responsible for such unauthorized use.
- The MOA reserves the right to limit the number of reproductions of works in its collections in any single publication if it appears that their number is disproportionate in relation to those from other sources.
- 10. The MOA reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to refuse permission for further applicants from a publisher or other applicants if, in its opinion, acceptable standards of reproduction of the MOA's objects have not been obtained or if adherence to the previous contracts has not been upheld.
